Disciplinary Code

The Club will consider offences whether they have been put through to the AFA by the Referee or not. More serious offences, such as racial abuse, will attract the immediate attention of the disciplinary committee and may result in immediate termination of membership. Players may be asked to attend a hearing of the disciplinary committee as and when the committee deems it necessary.

Any appeals must be addressed to the Club Captain, but it is only in the most exceptional circumstances that an appeal will be considered. As per FA ruling, cautions (yellow cards) cannot be appealed.

Reported cautions will attract the following internal disciplinary points in addition to any action taken by the League (SAL) and FA County body (AFA):

Offence	Points
Booking (other than for dissent)	1
Booking for dissent	4
Dismissal (excluding dissent)	6
Playing while suspended	8
Dismissal (dissent)	8
Booking/Dismissal (racism)	12

Minimum Fines

Fines	Amount Payable to Club (minimum)	Fines may be higher than the imposed minimum depending on offence and any subsequent League or County FA action. The fine amount is payable within 14 days of the offence, failure to pay will result in indefinite suspension until the debt is repaid regardless of the members financial status.

Do not wash your boots in the showers	Always help put up and take down goals & flags
Socialise with the opposition after the game	
Always make the Referee feel welcome	
Treat the club equipment and kit with respect	
Offer to help the Captain	
Respect the neighbours as you leave the Club
